

***2026 Ag Days @ Washington County, PA Fairgrounds***  
***Old-Fashioned Apple-Pie Contest Rules***



1. Apple Pies should be freshly baked and homemade. (It is suggested, but not recommended the filling consist of mainly apples.)
2. Apple Pies will be accepted Saturday April 18<sup>th</sup>, 2026 from Noon to 2pm. inside the Hog Father's Kitchen in the Food Court of the Fairgrounds.  
\*Signage will be Posted
3. The contest will have both a Junior (21 Yrs. Old or Younger) & Senior Division, based on the number of entries.
4. Apple Pies will be judged on the criteria of appearance, crust, filling, taste and texture.
5. The panel of judges will select an overall Prettiest Pie from the two divisions.
6. The top three pies from each division & the overall prettiest pie will receive a cash prize
  - a. 1<sup>s</sup> Place-\$50.00, 2<sup>nd</sup> Place-\$25.00, 3<sup>rd</sup> Place-\$15.00 and Overall Prettiest Pie-\$20.00
7. All Apple Pies once entered become property of the Washington County Cattlemen's Assoc. & will be up for auction.
  - a. The Auction will commence Saturday April 18<sup>th</sup>, 2026 at 6:30pm. at the Main Stage inside Hall 1 of the Fairgrounds.
8. All proceeds from the auction benefit the Washington County Cattlemen's Assoc. Educational Grant Scholarship Program. Junior Members of the WCCA are eligible to apply for the grant scholarship (\$3,000) following 1 year of post-secondary education. (Ex. Trade School, College ect.) In 2025, we raised \$11,375.00!
